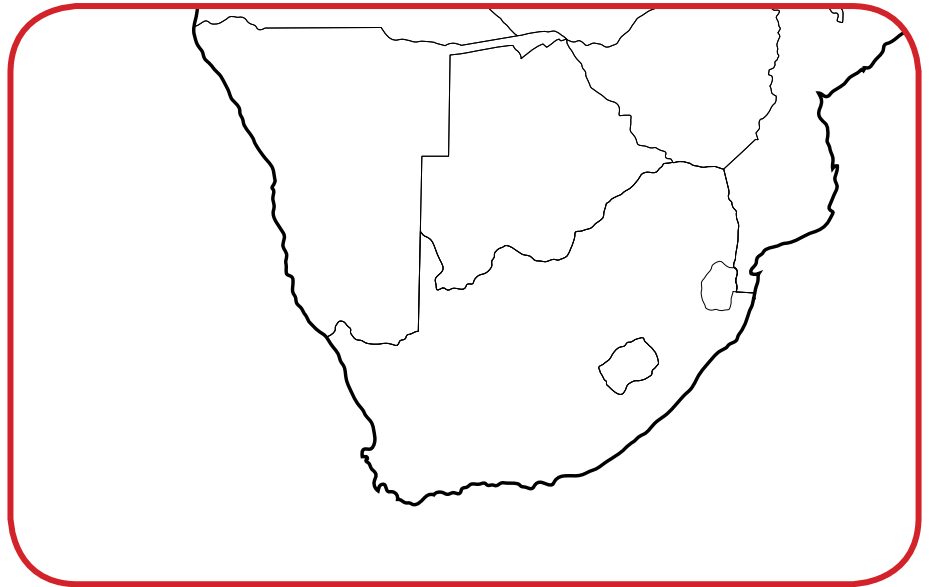

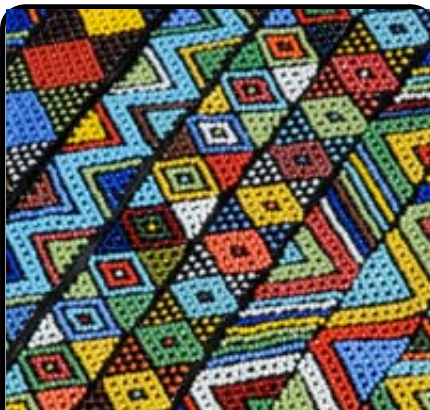

Match the African animals with their names.

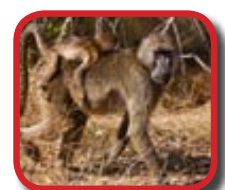
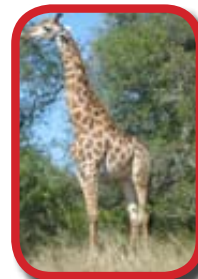
